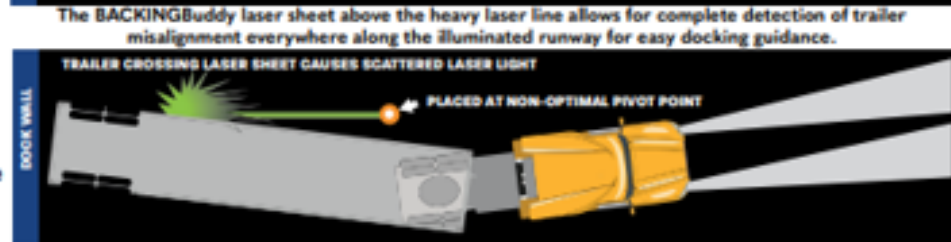
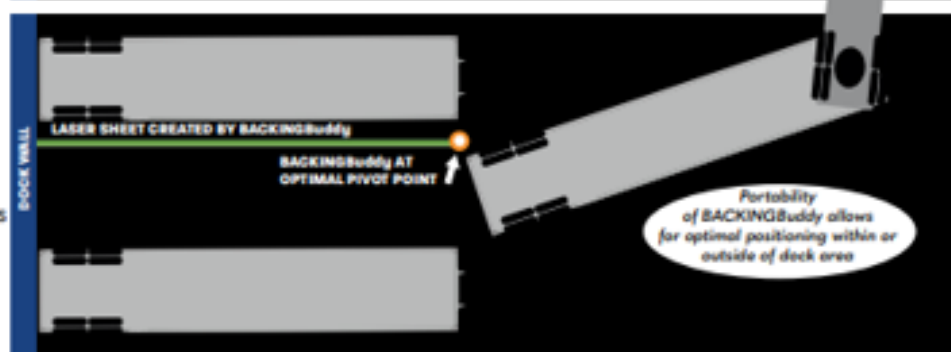
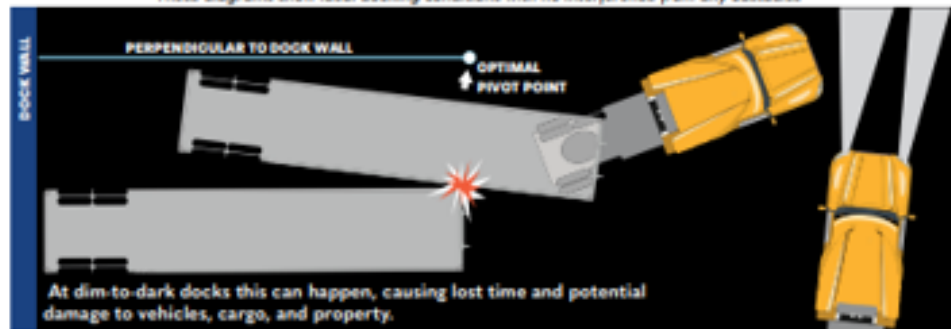
## A REVOLUTIONARY DEVICE TO MAKE DIFFICULT DOCKING SCENARIOS FASTER AND EASIER

*BACKINGBuddy is a rugged, portable, docking tool that radiates white up light and illuminates a heavy laser line projection, or runway, for docking during black of the night conditions.*

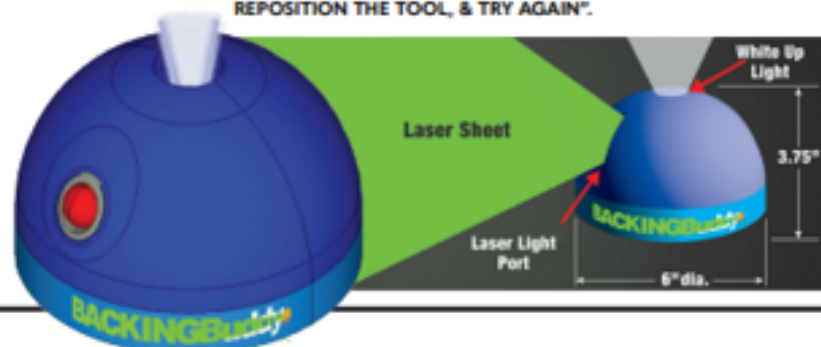
As per CDL training protocol – this device empowers the trucker to efficiently back a trailer into a dock – where there's no dock lighting. The device is positioned at a reference pivot point and it is rotated as shown (at ideal docks without docking obstacles like: cars, dumpsters, trucks, trailers, etc. in the dock area) so the laser port is directed towards the dock wall.

*These diagrams show ideal docking conditions with no interference from any obstacles*

- For tough docks with obstacles; portability allows for moving the tool to any optimal pivot point referencing where to pivot the tandem axes about.
- Introducing this tool directly to the CDL training centers will equip truckers to learn how to use the tool efficiently. It can also open other backing schemes to successfully dock a trailer – otherwise not possible without the use of this product.
- Tool usage can reduce incidents related to dark docking accidents while reducing potential insurance costs.
- The tool minimizes the time it takes to dock a trailer under pitch-black conditions thereby minimizing driver fatigue while promoting trucker well being.
- Permanently mounting this tool at ideal docks can eliminate excess dock lighting and can minimize lighting costs potentially.
- Exterior lighting components vulnerable to failure and/or damage from misuse can be replaced easily. The housing protects the internal electronics for a lifetime of repeatable and reliable use.
- This tool can be used for primitive guidance of other vehicles like: campers, farming, aircraft, marine, and military, etc.



If the trailer crosses the laser runway projection, the laser light scatters indicating the driver to "STOP, REPOSITION THE TOOL, & TRY AGAIN".
